MedInfo® provides post market information to healthcare professionals to enhance communication of new drug safety information, raise awareness of reported adverse events, and stimulate additional adverse event reporting.

MedInfo® Medication Guides convey risk information that is specific to particular drugs and drug classes, and contains FDA-approved information, which can help patients avoid serious adverse events.

MedInfo® integrates with E*Prescribe © - an Integrated Prescription Management System, and provides physician's with point-of-care access for the transition of prescriptions electronically. The system offers patients with access to the pharmacy of their choice; and to the clinical decision support network, including interactions with existing drugs, duplicate medications, drug allergies and inconsistency in dosage. Given that each prescription is electronically captured, this innovative process provides legible certification, decreasing prescription errors caused by hard-to-read handwriting. The integrated automation process and vital inspection of drug interactions and allergies, leads to improve patient safety and increased efficiency.
